General Meeting, October 15, 2019 Trevor Swanson

Trevor V. Swanson is one of the most gifted and promising wildlife artists in the world today. Coming from a long line of talented artists, Trevor is a brilliant example of inspired talent passing from one generation to another. Trevor started painting at a very young age and launched his career by the age of 20.

In his presentation and demonstration Trevor will discuss design, style, and inspiration for the piece and materials used in various examples and the hands on demonstrations. He will bring paintings in their various stages to give a good understanding of what his pieces look like through the stages. He welcomes questions and enjoys talking about the process and explaining the why's and what fors during this. He will demonstrate a painting in the drawing stage and do the initial laydown of the foundational layer. This is a good way to showcase brush and material choice at this point.

The Open Studio provides room to work on large pieces, camaraderie, and lively conversation about art and the creative process. Meeting weekly

humble beginnings he became world famous by hard work and dedication to his craft.



Just think what we can accomplish today with electric lights, library books, Google and access to high quality art supplies. All

things come to those who persist so you may be the next Remington, Millet, Vermeer, Warhol or Picasso. That is where the AAG comes in. AAG exists to help you become the best artist you can be.

Well let's get down to what is happening at the AAG. This month, on October 18, 10am to 4pm, Ann Osgood is giving a workshop on painting BIG flowers with gold and silver leaf backgrounds. Sculptor's Group Meeting

Joan Waters - Discussion and presentation of her work and artistic process and Interactive Project.

Monday, October 7, 2019 | 7-9pm Location: 2141 E. Cedar Street, #1, Tempe, AZ 85281 (near the intersection of the 101 and 202 in Tempe.)

Please wear closed toe shoes.

This evening we'll explore some of Water's newest work which incorporates welded steel, glazed ceramics and reclaimed wood. We'll discuss the creative process, beginning with drawing and observing forms in nature, and embracing the unknown and uncertainty as vital parts of the work. With a background in painting and drawing, Waters sees working across different mediums as another way to work with color, line, texture and positive and negative shapes. Demonstration will include some metal processes, such as coloring steel with patinas and the torch, and discuss some of the unique challenges of combining different materials in these constructions. Bring your questions!

If we have time, we will do a 15-minute hands-on exercise where everyone can combine found objects into their own assemblage which they can photograph.
